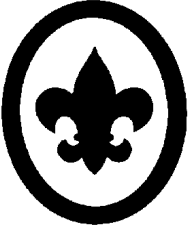
Scout Island

PACKING LIST

- Permission slip AND Authorization for Emergency Medical Treatment form
- Bike
- Helmet
- Water bottle
- Warm sleeping bag and ground pad and pillow (put inside a plastic trash bag and put your name on the outside with masking tape)
- Scout Handbook
- Pencil and Paper
- Flashlight with extra batteries
- Other 3 Troop 13 t-shirts (wear your blue shirt)
- Jeans
- Sweatpants
- Shorts
- Folding Pocket Knife
- Compass (if you have one)
- Clean underwear and Socks (extra socks are important)
- Something warm and dry to sleep in (sweats are great)
- Poncho or rain suit (pack on top)
- Coat or jacket, hat, and gloves (it could get chilly)
- Sweatshirt (Troop 13 sweatshirt if you have one)
- Shoes or Hiking Boots (a second pair is important for wet, dewy grass)
- Scout or similar cap if you want to wear one
- Toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, soap, deodorant, towel, etc.
- Bug / Tick Repellent (non-aerosol)
- Quiet entertainment like cards or books
- Sunscreen
- Camera (optional)
- Medicine (if you need it)
- Sunglasses (if you have a pair)
- Plastic bag for wet and dirty clothes
- Pack everything in a sports/duffel bag—put a nametag on the outside
