

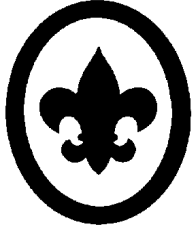

- Meet at Trinity United Methodist Church parking lot at 6:00 P.M. Friday
- Eat dinner before you arrive
- Wear your blue t-shirt

Make sure you pack **WARM** Clothes—It could get **VERY** Cold!

PACKING LIST

- **Permission slip AND Authorization for Emergency Medical Treatment form**—Make sure your forms are filled out **BEFORE** you arrive!
- **Scout Uniform** (put it on a hanger covered with a plastic bag. Put your name on a piece of masking tape on the bag. Include **scarf and clasp** (initial your uniform and scarf and button your clasp in your shirt pocket)
- **Sleeping bag and pillow** (put inside a plastic trash bag and put your name on the outside with masking tape)
- **Scout Handbook**
- **Pencil and Paper**
- **Flashlight** with extra Batteries
- **Other 3 Scout t-shirts** (wear your blue shirt)
- **Extra pair of jeans**
- **Sweatpants**
- **Folding Pocket Knife**
- **Clean underwear and Socks** (extra socks are important)
- Something warm and dry to **sleep in** (sweats are great)
- **WARM Coat or jacket, hat, and gloves**
- **Snow Boots**
- **Sweatshirt** (Scout sweatshirt if you have one)
- **Extra Shoes, Hiking Boots**
- **Toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, soap, deodorant, towel, etc.**
- **Canteen or Water Bottle**
- Quiet entertainment like **cards or books**
- **Camera** (optional)
- **Medicine** (if you need it)
- **Plastic bag** for wet and dirty clothes
- Pack everything in a **sports/duffel bag**—put a nametag on the outside
