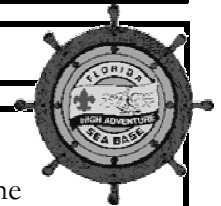
Troop 13 will provide beverages, silverware, plates, and napkins.

SEA BASE HEALTH FORMS

Sea Base requires a special, more complete health form. All participants will need to complete this form. This form is valid only for 12 months. Make sure you take the form to your physician after June 25th. If you need an exam for summer camp, you may want to get it scheduled for the beginning of July. Please make sure your name is on every form you turn in and make copies of all your forms.

SEA BASE FINANCES

If you are planning to go to Sea Base, you need to **pay a \$100 deposit**. We will begin to offer any open slots on our crew to other scouts, possibly in other troops. If, at a later date, you find you are unable to attend, you will receive your payment back if we are able to find another scout or adult to take your spot.

In September we will collect the second payment - an additional \$225. At this time we will have to have a final crew list as we will need to start travel arrangements.

The final Sea Base payment of \$325 is due March 1, 2008. Payments for travel expenses will need to be paid as the expenses occur. Every attempt will be made to keep costs low to make the trip affordable. The additional expense for travel is estimated to be \$600-800/participant.
