Order forms and information will be mailed to your house, along with a yard sign. Frames for the yard signs will be available at one of the meetings.

Although Troop 13 Scouts will not receive prizes (instead the Scouts will receive an additional 5%) there are several items Scouts can earn. For each \$375 worth of popcorn sold, your name will be entered into a drawing for Packer tickets. Sell over \$1,500 and you will receive a \$50 gift card, over \$2,000 and you will receive a free summer camp session at Camp Phillips, and over \$2,500 you will start a scholarship fund for your college.

Mystery Houses—Be the first Scout to sell popcorn to a mystery house and you will receive a pair of Packer tickets. This year you can receive clues about the mystery houses.
