NATIONAL SCOUT JAMBOREE 2013

Several Scouts have expressed interest in attending the 2013 National Scout Jamboree. To signup, go to the Council web site (bsa-cvc.org) and follow the link. You must register online AND submit a \$100 deposit to the Scout Center to be registered. If you would like to use money in your Troop Scout Account, please submit a receipt or other proof of payment to our treasurer (Mr. Scobie) and he will issue a reimbursement. Please read over ALL the information about the Jamboree before you register. The total trip cost will be \$1500-2000.

POPCORN SALES

SHOW AND SELL: Interested in being able to deliver the popcorn as soon as a customer orders? You can do that by ordering at the **September 12 meeting**. Please decide what popcorn you think you can sell and submit that order. You can still take orders if you run out, or they would like something you don't have and then deliver it after November 12. **All money and/or popcorn must be turned in at the October 23rd Packer Party. Popcorn returned MUST be in sellable state.**

PRIZES: Troop 13 has elected not to receive sale prizes and instead will receive an extra 5% from the sale. BUT there are some bonuses you can receive: **For each \$600** in sales, you will get a **Zyclone**. Sell **\$1,500** and you will receive a \$50 Amazon or Wal-Mart gift Card. Sell **\$2,000** and you will receive a free **Full Campership for 2012** (worth about \$200), and sell **\$2,500** and a scholarship will be started for your college tuition.

FILL A FORM DRAWING: If you **fill up an order form**, get it to the scout office by **2pm on October 10, 17, or 24** to be entered into the weekly drawing for council and district prizes (Nintendo, iPod, or gift cards).

Sale starts **October 1st** and ends **October 22nd**. **Orders are due at the Packer Party on October 23rd**. Popcorn pickup is **November 12**. Payments must be made by **November 28**.
